



Mill Hill signs up to army bursaries

ForceSelect, the UK's leading military service leaver recruitment consultancy, has signed an agreement with leading independent school Mill Hill to provide bursaries for the children of military staff and service leavers. ForceSelect will work with a London regiment for the pilot scheme to identify children of service families eligible for bursary places at Mill Hill School to be awarded for the start of the autumn term in 2011.

The bursaries are for up to 100% of annual fees which are currently £25,500 per annum for boarders, who attend the school from the ages of 13

to 18 and from £14,000 per annum for day pupils, who attend the school from the ages of 11-18. In addition, Mill Hill will offer a discount of 20% on fees to children of service leavers, as well as currently serving Forces personnel, who do not qualify for the bursaries. The scheme is also open to the children of service widows and those who have been medically discharged.

ForceSelect plans to extend the scheme to a tri-service offering to include a network of independent schools across the UK.
