### REC and IRP members among the honours in Recruiter Awards for Excellence 2011

Released on 12 May 2011

Members of the REC and IRP were recognised for their outstanding achievements at last night's Recruiter Awards for Excellence 2011 attended by 1,200 people at the Grosvenor House Hotel in London.

A total of 12 of the 26 awards were presented to members at the ceremony hosted by comedian, TV host and author Dara O'Briain.

There were double celebrations for Meridian Business Support which was not only proclaimed Best Temporary Recruitment Agency but whose human resources director, Louise McCarthy-Teague was crowned Recruitment Personality of the Year.

ITN Mark Education was top of the class as Best Public Sector Recruitment Agency while Impact Teachers were given top marks in the Best Candidate Care category.

The Best Engineering Recruitment Agency title went to CBSbutler and Penta Consulting showed it was world class by being voted Best International Recruitment Agency.
